

## East House - List of Items Needed

### **We accept, in good condition, the following items:**

#### **Furniture:**

Bed frames, dressers  
New mattresses/box springs  
Living Room furniture  
Kitchen tables, chairs  
Desks, Lamps  
Stand-up freezer; Refrigerator with ice maker and water tap for group home

*\* We do not accept: used mattresses or box springs; used futons*

#### **Household Goods:**

New comforters, blankets, sheets  
New hygiene products (unopened shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc.)  
Framed artwork or prints  
Small appliances such as blenders, toasters  
Curtains, Area Rugs  
Gift cards for grocery stores  
Dishes, pots, pans, silverware, glassware  
Tupperware  
Vacuum cleaners

*\* We do not accept used comforters, blankets, sheets, partially-used hygiene products*

#### **Office Equipment/Electronics: must be in good working order**

Updated, flat-screen TV's (older models also accepted)

Personal CD players  
Headphones/Ear buds  
Flash drives  
Phones/answer machines  
Printers/scanners

*\* We do not accept: Computers less than Pentium 4. Computer Operating System less than XP, CRT monitors, Mac or Apple machines, Inkjet printers or tractor-feed printers*

#### **Games/Recreation:**

New Board games  
Group tickets to sporting events, concerts and plays  
YMCA and other Gym memberships for residents  
Fiction books/novels, National Geographic magazines  
Wii and Wii fit, as well as Wii games  
Adult sporting equipment, baseballs, bats and gloves, basketballs, footballs  
Pool Table  
Sewing machine  
Craft supplies, craft storage and drawing paper

#### **Clothing:**

To provide **tutoring** to individuals in literacy training, GED preparation, adult basic education and basic computer skills training. (Minimum of one hour per week.) Be Classroom Aides. (Training is provided for both tutors and aides.)

Spend an hour or two a week of **social time** in a group home. (Make crafts or play games with residents, take them for a walk, help out at dinner time, etc.) Professional stylists/cosmetologists to assist with preparing individuals for interviewing/job seeking.
